# About Emmy's Academy

#### THE CALL

Long before the doors opened to Emmy's Academy, a full-time early intervention chidcarecenter, the fabric was being woven. Born on April18, 2007, Emmy Corrigan brought light to all who knew her and from her beautiful life and time here with us, her mother, Amy, recognized a need in our community. That need was to serve and help families with children living with special needs. At first, providing a safe place for these beautiful children to be cared for, offering respite nights to their parents.

Today, 10 years after Emmy's life here on Earth, a full-time learning center now stands to help care for children with special needs on a daily basis from morning to evening. What was only a vision, Amy Corrigan made a reality and she tirelessly serves, works and gives of herself to these children and families

#### THE MISSION

Established as a not-for-profit organization, Emmy's Academy provides an early learning environment with low student-to-teacher ratios. We offer a tailored experience where all children have access to on-site physical, occupational, speech and music therapies. Children ages 6 weeks through 6 years, regardless of diagnosis or special circumstances, are provided a warm, friendly environment, enabling their parents to work and provide for their needs. Our mission is to provide affordable, developmentally appropriate care for children with special needs and support for their families.

#### THE NEED

Today, to operate on an annual basis and care for these children, expenses are in excess of \$250K annually. Providing a 1:3 ratio for the children and finding highly-trained staff and Special Education teachers is essential to Emmy's Academy, all while keeping the cost to families as low as possible. Presently, there is a need to makeover the playground where all children can navigate it, regardless of their disability to enjoy the sunshine each day. Additionally, an in-house physical therapy room is also desired for the children's continued muscular development.
